On Monday 5th January, when the change came into effect. two volunteers were handing out the LCC "Support bus lane watch" cards at Madras Place and on Holloway Road. They found this to be useful as many cyclists were unaware of the new situation with PTWs (Powered Two Wheelers). They were relieved to know that they could influence the Mayor about whether it will be made permanent. Thanks to those who helped with this.

Motor bikes in bus lanes Back in November three volunteers turned out on two cold mornings to count the cyclists using the bus lane Holloway Road. At the junction of Hornsey Road & Hollowav Road (opposite the tube station) we counted an average of just over 300 cyclists travelling south on the Holloway Road between 8.00-9.30am and 39 PTWs (Powered Two Wheelers) travelling in the bus lane. We also counted an average of 181 cyclists waiting in the ASL (advanced stop line) and 56 PTWs illegally entering the ASL after the light has changed red. Now PTWs are allowed to use the bus lanes on Red Routes we will be doing further counts at this location to see how the situation changes.
