Width restriction Drayton Park

This has attracted much activity on our website. Designed to reduce HGV traffic speed, it has meant the loss of part of the cycle lane on the 2nd busiest cycle lane in the borough. A council officer wrote, "(The present scheme is)... less **preferable** for cyclists, however we do not feel the current layout is unsafe for cyclists for a number of reasons." This width restriction (2 metres), still allows quite large vehicles to pass through, see below.
