2	Minutes of last meeting - actions arising <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Issues with onboarding. EM is getting the process from HQ and will share it with SM and JD'H.</li> <li>Freecycle feeders to discuss with police involvement. Action carried over.</li> <li>NK reported that council will not be soliciting responses in their consultation other than comments on the blue badge change in Highbury.</li> <li>Design of the five asks on LCC website. EM is liaising with LCC. Carried over.</li> <li>Mildmay Liveable Neighbourhood. OL attended. Proposals will be forthcoming - likely Sept / October. Potentially £500k for Mildmay ward. CI will want to respond when the proposals are out. OL to keep the group updated.</li> <li>Holloway road bike lane removal. Latest update is Islington Living Streets keen to help apply some pressure to get the scheme prioritised. Firstly going to check with Rowena / Islington their position on the scheme and then will follow-up with TfL / Assembly.</li> <li>JA took a look at the local plan consultation. TB has sent in a personal response and someone from Islington Alliance has done a decent response on climate. JA says we need a local plan to hit net zero targets and will draft an email to transport planners whether it is fit for purpose (NK will send it). Very weak on cargo delivery and consolidation despite commitments in transport strategy.</li> <li>Terms of reference – LCC says it's not a problem for them – up to us whether we want to sign it or not. JAH took some cards.</li> <li>Make the lane - Thursday 22 September 8-9.30am. Car free day so it fits well. Lots of actions from the subgroup meeting. Clerkenwell 'boulevard' (but please don't call it that) and please invite friends. Joint action with Camden asking for segregation. Update at next meeting.</li> </ul>	All EM, AS et al

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Beech Street - update from Oli that City want to bring back electric vehicles street scheme under the Barbican but Islington Council are blocking at the moment owing to supposed traffic impacts on bunhill area. NK/OL to follow-up with council.</li> <li>● Update on council liaison - very productive! <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ <a href="#">Consultation on Charlton Place</a> closing this off to cars exiting onto Upper Street. Small change but will benefit cycles well because there will be two-way. Council keen for residents to respond.</li> <li>○ Mopeds parking in front of McDonalds on double red lines. NK has raised with TfL.</li> <li>○ Highbury Corner pedestrian space in front of station is complex and won't be pursued further.</li> <li>○ New council officer working on cycle parking and further update next month.</li> <li>○ Green Lanes cycle track has been made permanent woo.</li> <li>○ Gearing up to implement Nag's Head gyratory improvements in autumn. Nine months build as an ETO, with consultation six months after build.</li> <li>○ A1 Drayton Park changes ready to go when money is available and will be dependent on Barnsbury LTN scheme (expected autumn).</li> <li>○ Hornsey Road cycle lanes to Highgate scheme, hiring project manager and may happen as part of C50.</li> <li>○ Cycleway 38 (Liverpool Road) close to going permanent with some minor amends.</li> <li>○ Better Leisure (Market Road) have identified some areas for more cycle parking but no CCTV and recognise its a problem.</li> </ul> </li> <li>● Five asks <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Website tool in progress at the moment. Ready by 22 September for full council meeting.</li> </ul> </li> <li>● Cycle buddies <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Five new people joined the cycle buddies scheme since the last meeting. We now need to ensure we have enough experienced riders so SM will send out an email but for now everyone needs to use the link on the website. There will soon be an app available by LCC to make this easier.</li> </ul> </li> <li>● Social rides <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Kidical Mass had around 20 people on the feeder ride and we got interest in future rides.</li> <li>○ Second Joy Riders ride to Canary Wharf with 9 women. Next one is 21 August to Battersea.</li> <li>○ Picnic ride on 7 August was fun</li> <li>○ Future rides include doing a family ride (TBC half term?), bikers' breakfast to get more members Angel triangle (13 October), JAH doing ride to Walthamstow village (Sept TBC led by JAH), evening ride TBC late Oct (OL)</li> </ul> </li> <li>● LCC AGM and campaigners' conference (15 October)</li> <li>● Camden passage consultation live, please complete.</li> <li>● Electric cargo bike scheme with Pedal My Wheels is live and worth having a go.</li> <li>● Urban hill climb on Swain's Lane in Highgate - Saturday 24 September.
