Minutes

Matters arising:

- Steve K's fee for leading the freecycle ride. Keith to decide whether to donate it to LCC or otherwise direct it.
- TfL Plan for the Angel, Julio meeting with them soon
- FR2: Nick, Julio and Camden to collaborate on response re FR2. No plans seen, rumours about problems. Julio following up with Sophie E
- Problems continue with cycling/pedestrian drop-offs at Waste & recycling centre
- Nicolina Cooper has abruptly left the council, Steve K getting an updated org chart.

Freecycle: 85 people riding down to central London, less on the return ride. Steve reports "everyone had a good time", Nick: "perfect weather"

Simon Munk meeting with committee: Eilidh describes Simon's view: we should encourage and praise the council, who are at a 'tipping point'. Chris K apparently doesn't share this view.

Transport Strategy consultation;

- Strategy may need to be redone b/c of climate emergency.
- Strategy is very poor, full of lazy statements, meaningless goals and targets that can't be realistically met.
- Need to be very careful to sandwich criticisms with good points.
- Talia H to set up notes for discussion at next meeting.

Officers meeting update from Nick K:

- FR2 consultation appears to be going ahead.
- Filtering trial working well, CI should be enthusiastic
- Old Street meeting imminent
- EV parking / charging points being reviewed by Richard A
- QW10 consultation to be released in October.
- QW2: Removing through traffic on Prebend Street and Amwell Street as a trial. Coming sometime next year, need to build support. Amwell Society against traffic reduction b/c "shops will close" Islington doing traffic counts.
- Richard A reviewing problems with re-striping and re-paving to coordinate with updates to street infra
- Balls pond road: Islington going to do what TfL wants bi-directional track on North side and complain after
- Low traffic neighbourhoods: Chris K shared crayon's output with Richard W. Nick K to follow up with Richard A.
